Wed 01 May. Depart Australia

Thurs 02 May. Arrive Amsterdam

Fri 03 May. Amsterdam. Aalsemere Flower Auctions Volendam (B)

Sat 04 May. Visit to Keukenhof Flower Gardens (B)

Sun 05 May. 15 day Avalon river cruise. (B) Amsterdam, Holland. (Embarkation) Your Suite Ship is Ready for boarding. Guests must be on board ship by 5 pm. Spend free time exploring the colourful streets, bridges, and canals of Amsterdam-with its many cafés and art galleries. Overnight docking in Amsterdam. (D)
